If you're 18 years of age or older, join the team of Beverage Cashiers in the Beer Tents and ensure our festival-goers get their tasty adult beverages in a quick & orderly manner. Limited youth positions available for 15-17 year olds to work in pop tents and ice cream carts, keeping people refreshed and cool this summer.

The Beverage Cashiers team works in the Beer Tents, pop tents, and with the ice cream carts. Volunteers are responsible for proper IDing, taking drink orders, and taking payment. Duties in this area are varied and will be assigned by a supervisor on a shift-by-shift basis.
